

## Blind Trail (BT)

### Start

You will be stopped along the route and informed about average speed and maximum distance of the Blind Trails. Start according to the instructions of the officials. The time measurement begins when the front wheels touch the hose which is fixed to the ground.

### Finish

The finish of the Blind Trails is located between your present position and the end of the maximum stretch. The actual distance of the Blind Trails will not be announced in advance. The finishing will also be measured electronically (Hose). **No stopping of the vehicles in the visual range of the finish team (penalty points)!**

### Penalty points

+/- 1/10 second deviation = 1 penalty point

### Calculation of your arrival time at the next stage finish

For the calculation of your arrival time at the next stage finish consider the actual distance of the Blind Trails (→ please look out for the sign at the finish of the Blind Trails which indicates the actual distance) and the given average speed.

### Example

Average speed 30 km/h, maximum distance 5 km. The finish is located between your present location and the point you will pass after maximum 5 km of driving according to the roadbook. Drive in such a way, that you can pass the finish with an average speed of 30 km over the covered stretch. As soon as you see the officials' team at the finish, no stopping is allowed (penalty points). Make a note of the actual distance of the Blind Trails which is indicated on a sign at the finish, to be able to calculate your correct arrival time at the next stage finish.
